



18 The Commissioner ("Commissioner") of the California Department of Real Estate
19 ("Department") caused an investigation to be made of the activities of FEDERAL MORTGAGE
20 SOLUTIONS, LLC ("FMS") and PAUL MAXFIELD HERMAN ("HERMAN"). Based on that
21 investigation, the Commissioner has determined that FMS and HERMAN have engaged in, are
22 engaging in, or are attempting to engage in, acts or practices constituting violations of the
23 California Business and Professions Code ("Code") and/or Title 10, California Code of
24 Regulations ("Regulations"), including the business of, acting in the capacity of, and/or
25 advertising or assuming to act as, a real estate broker in the State of California within the
26 meaning of Code Section 10131(d) (performing services for borrowers in connection with loans
27

1 solicited borrowers to negotiate loans secured by real property for compensation or in
2 expectation of compensation to NMS.

3 3. HERMAN has been licensed by the Department as a real estate salesperson since March
4 6, 2002. E-RealtyHomes.com Inc. in Tarzana, California is presently listed as HERMAN's
5 employing broker.

6 4. On or about February 27, 2009, March 27, 2009, and April 27, 2009, Jeff K. and Susan
7 K. made three payments by credit card totaling \$6,500.00 to FMS/NMS as advance fees,
8 pursuant to an agreement pertaining to loan solicitation, negotiation, and modification services to
9 be provided by FMS with respect to a loan secured by real property located at 2155 Ward Way,
10 Woodside, California 94062. After six months, Jeff K. and Susan K. received no results on their
11 loan and learned that FMS/NMS had not worked on negotiating or modifying the terms of his
12 loan on their Woodside property and requested a refund. When FMS/NMS did not respond to
13 Jeff and Susan K.'s refund demand, Jeff and Susan engaged the services of an attorney to file a
14 Complaint with the San Mateo County District Attorney's Office.
15

16 5. On or about March 1, 2009, NMS and FMS distributed advertising materials regarding
17 loan modification and negotiation services and solicited consumer Steve L.
18

19 6. On or about June 17, 2009 Chesley R. paid to FMS/NMS an advance fee of \$2,720.00
20 by credit card, pursuant to an agreement pertaining to loan solicitation, negotiation, and
21 modification services to be provided by FMS with respect to a loan secured by real property
22 located at 3055 Quail Road in Escondido, California 92026. After four months, Chesley R.
23 learned that FMS had not worked on negotiating or modifying the terms of the loan on the
24 Escondido property and requested a refund. FMS did not respond to Chesley R.'s refund
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26
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1 demand. On or about November 5, 2009, Chesley R. engaged the services of an attorney for
2 assistance.

3 7. On or about May 22, 2009, Edward M. paid to FMS/NMS an advance fee of \$2,720.00
4 by check, pursuant to an agreement pertaining to loan solicitation, negotiation, and modification
5 services to be provided by FMS with respect to a loan secured by real property located at 519
6 Sycamore Street, Fairfield, California 94533. After six months, Edward M. learned that FMS
7 had not worked on negotiating or modifying the terms of the loan on the Fairfield property and
8 requested a refund. FMS did not respond to Edward M. and it did not return his money.

10 11 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

13 8. Based on the findings of fact contained in paragraphs 1 through 7, FMS, acting by
14 itself, or by and/or through one or more agents, associates, affiliates, and/or co-conspirators,
15 including, but not limited to HERMAN, and using the name "FEDERAL MORTGAGE
16 SOLUTIONS, LLC," or other names or fictitious names unknown at this time, solicited
17 borrowers to negotiate loans or perform services, in connection with loans secured directly or
18 collaterally by one or more liens on real property. These acts, which require a real estate broker
19 license under Section 10131(d) of the Code, were performed during a period of time when FMS
20 was not licensed by the Department as a real estate broker, a violation of Code Section 10130.

21 9. Based on the findings of fact contained in paragraphs 1 through 7, HERMAN, acting
22 by himself, or by and/or through one or more agents, associates, affiliates, and/or co-
23 conspirators, including, but not limited to FMS, and using the name "FEDERAL MORTGAGE
24 SOLUTIONS, LLC," or other names or fictitious names unknown at this time, solicited
25 borrowers to negotiate loans or perform services, in connection with loans secured directly or
26 collaterally by one or more liens on real property. These acts, which require a real estate broker
27 license under Section 10131(d) of the Code, were performed during a period of time when

1 HERMAN and FMS were not licensed by the Department as a real estate broker, a violation of
2 Code Section 10130.


3 DESIST AND REFRAIN ORDER

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5 Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated herein, it is hereby
6 ordered that FEDERAL MORTGAGE SOLUTIONS, LLC, whether doing business under your
7 own name or as National Mortgage Solutions, LLC, or any other name(s) or fictitious name(s),
8 and PAUL MAXFIELD HERMAN, whether doing business under his own name(s) or any other
9 fictitious name(s), ARE HEREBY ORDERED to immediately desist and refrain from performing
10 any acts within the State of California for which a real estate broker license is required, unless
11 you are so licensed. In particular each of them is ORDERED TO DESIST AND REFRAIN
12 from:
13

- 14 1. charging, demanding, claiming, collecting and/or receiving advance fees, as that term
15 is defined in Section 10026 of the Code, in any form, and under any conditions, with
16 respect to the performance of loan modifications or any other form of mortgage loan
17 forbearance service in connection with loans on residential property containing four
18 or fewer dwelling units; and
- 19 2. charging, demanding, claiming, collecting and/or receiving advance fees, as that term
20 is defined in Section 10026 of the Code, for any other real estate related services
21 offered by them to others.

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Notice: Business and Professions Code Section 10139 provides that “Any person acting as a real estate broker or real estate salesperson without a license or who advertises using words indicating that he or she is a real estate broker without being so licensed shall be guilty of a public offense punishable by a fine not exceeding twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed six months, or by both fine and imprisonment; or if a corporation, be punished by a fine not exceeding sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000).”
